



Principal Allan Cheng Scholarship

Ying Wa College is dedicated to providing quality education to all students. We believe that no one should be deprived of the opportunity to study at Ying Wa College due to financial constraints. This scholarship, generously donated by the Lu's Foundation Limited in honour of Mr. Cheng Kwun Kit, Allan, the 18th Principal of Ying Wa College, aims to support students with financial needs by providing funding for their local and overseas learning activities. It is a subsidy in addition to the Ying Wa Old Boys' Association Education Fund for Cross Boundary Learning Activities.

Rules and Regulations:

1. The target beneficiaries of this scholarship are S1 to S6 students who are the recipients of the Comprehensive Social Security Assistance Scheme (CSSA), or full/ half grant provided by the Student Financial Assistance Agency (SFAA). Students who meet the College's criteria for "financial need" are also eligible.
2. Applicants may still receive other forms of prize or scholarships, e.g. Ying Wa Old Boys' Association Education Fund for Cross Boundary Learning Activities.
3. Each eligible student can apply once in each academic stage (i.e. S1 - S3 and S4 - S6).
4. The maximum amount of this scholarship is HK\$20,000 per applicant in each academic stage. Students who receive CSSA, or a full grant from the SFAA are eligible for a maximum of HK\$20,000, while students who receive a half grant from SFAA are eligible for a maximum of HK\$10,000.
5. This scholarship covers both local and overseas learning activities organized by a registered organization other than the school.
6. Prior application is required. Students must complete and submit the form of application to the Student Welfare Committee of the school for approval at least two weeks before the start of the learning activity.
7. Applicants will be invited to attend an interview.
8. Awardees must submit a learning reflection of 500 words in Chinese or 300 words in English, along with 3 photographs of the learning activities, to the Lu's Foundation Limited, the donor of this scholarship, through the College, two weeks after the completion of the learning activity.
9. Ying Wa College reserves the right to approve or reject applications at its discretion.
